Driving Directions for Day 7 – Saturday, June 27, 2009

1. General Directions to the parking lot at Penn's Landing Visitor's Center, 301 S. Columbus Blvd., Philadelphia, PA (215) 928-8801

From Interstate 95, take Exit 20 for Columbus Blvd./Penn's Landing/Washington Ave. (this exit is on your Left hand side if you're traveling Southbound).

Make a Left at the traffic light onto S. Columbus Blvd.

The parking lot is on the Right less than half a mile up the road. It's the employee parking lot (marked as such) at the yellow operations building on your right. It is across from Spruce Street. You will receive a tag for your vehicle identifying you are with the Sojourn once you arrive.

Registration for the Sojourn will be in the Penn's Landing Visitor's Center.

2. Directions to Penn's Landing Visitors Center, Philadelphia, PA from Palmyra Cove Nature Park, Palmyra, NJ: ~11miles/20 minutes

Exit Palmyra Cove Nature Park and follow signs for the Tacony Palmyra Bridge/ Route 73 West

Once you go over the Tacony Palmyra Bridge into PA, make Left onto State Road/Tacony Street. Follow for ~1 ½ miles.

Make Left onto Aramingo Avenue and follow signs for Interstate 95 South.

Take the ramp for Interstate 95 South. Take 95 South for ~6 miles.

Take Exit #20 ON THE LEFT for Columbus Blvd./Penn's Landing/Washington Ave.

Make a Left at the traffic light onto S. Columbus Blvd.

The parking lot is on the Right less than half a mile up the road. It's the employee parking lot (marked as such) at the yellow operations building on your right. It is across from Spruce

Street. You will receive a tag for your vehicle identifying you are with the Sojourn once you arrive.

Registration for the Sojourn will be in the Penn's Landing Visitor's Center.
