Standards Review Committee Meeting

- The Standards Review Committee and 3 subcommittees (K-2, ELA, and mathematics) met September 1, 2015 from 9:00 - 3:00.
- The work day began with a general session for all committee members to discuss the standards revision process, the timeline, and the commitments.
- Committees then moved into breakout sessions for the remainder of the day with the NJDOE leaders and content specialist facilitators.

Listening Tours

Over a four-week period, we will travel to three regions and spend approximately nine hours listening to participants throughout the state as a strategy to collect perspectives that will help to inform the review process.
