Repeat entire song with “He did.” and point to boys.

Repeat entire song with “She did.” and point to girls.

Repeat entire song with “They did.” and point to other children.

Repeat song with “We did.” And point to self and another child.

“Joe” (Source unknown)

Hello. My name is Joe and I work in a factory.

I have a dog and a cat and a family.

One day, my boss came up to me.

He said, “Joe, are you busy?”

I said, “No.”

“Turn the handle with your hand.” (Wave hand back and forth.)

(Repeat entire song. When you get to last line change to, “Turn the handle with your other hand” and wave both hands.)

(Repeat entire song. When you get to last line, change to, “Turn the handle with your foot.” And move front of foot back and forth.)

(Repeat entire song....change to other foot and move both feet back and forth.)

(Repeat entire song...add, “Turn the handle with your head.” And move head up and down.)

Repeat entire song, but after.... “Are you busy?” ... change to “Yes!”
