“How Bystanders Become Upstanders: Using Tactics to Prevent Bullying and Helping Rescue Jews During the Holocaust Years”

Bullying is the number one systemic problem in schools today. Who are the targets of bullying and why? How can we prevent bullying from occurring? How we can intervene in situations of bias or bullying. Participants will learn how to incorporate issues of bullying into lesson plans and have an opportunity to utilize these skills in workshop activities. We will discuss utilizing best practices in a school district. There will be Q & A, handouts with resources, videos, and book references will be provided for participants to utilize in their school.

The second part of the workshop will discuss the rescue efforts in the community of LeChambon, in France. It will focus on the conditions that enabled the residents to hide Jews during the Holocaust years. This presentation will include the documentary, “Weapons of The Spirit.”
