SYNOPSIS

The Board certified tenure charges of unbecoming conduct, neglect and other just cause against respondent, a middle school teacher of classified students in a self-contained classroom of emotionally disturbed children, for an incident in which she allegedly directed an inappropriate comment at two classified students.

The ALJ found that the incident demonstrated respondent's insensitivity to her emotionally handicapped students and resulted in one student being so embarrassed that he remains on home instruction. Having found the incident "sufficiently flagrant" to remove respondent from her tenured position, the ALJ ordered said removal.

The Commissioner adopted findings and determination in the Initial Decision as his own and ordered respondent dismissed as of the date of this decision. The Commissioner directed that a copy of the decision be transmitted to the State Board of Examiners for action as it deems appropriate, pursuant to *N.J.A.C.* 6:11-3.6.
