SYNOPSIS

Petitioner, applicant for teacher certification through the Alternate Route Program, challenged respondent's determination that she is disqualified from school employment pursuant to *N.J.S.A.* 18A:6-7.1 based on her conviction for "death by auto."

The ALJ determined that petitioner's 1990 conviction under *N.J.S.A.* 2C:11-5, which was a third degree crime at that time, constituted a disqualifying offense because the crime is "substantially equivalent" to the second degree crime of vehicular homicide in the amended *N.J.S.A.* 2C:11-5. Moreover, the elements of petitioner's crime involved both the use and threat of force upon a person.

The Commissioner affirmed the decision of the ALJ for the reasons set forth therein.
