## COMMISSIONER OF EDUCATION

## DECISION

On April 23, 2008, a final agency decision was rendered in this matter, wherein the Commissioner ordered that petitioner, Zoe Ajjahnon, be assessed tuition in the amount of 22,625.66, plus 58.75 per diem for each day of attendance after March 5, 2008, to compensate the Saddle River Board of Education for her child J.K.'s period of ineligible attendance in the public schools of the district pursuant to *N.J.S.A.* 18A:38-1. The Board subsequently requested that the Commissioner seek entry of this assessment – which then totaled 26,973.16, due to 74 days of additional attendance by J.K. – on the judgment docket of the Superior Court pursuant to *N.J.S.A.* 2A:58-10; the Board further advised that Zoe Ajjahnon uses an alias and requested that the judgment against her be entered in the name of "Zoe Ajjahnon, also known as Joan Green." Petitioner offered no reasons why the judgment against her should not be so docketed, although given an opportunity by this agency to do so.<sup>\*</sup>

Accordingly, pursuant to *N.J.S.A.* 2A:58-10, Zoe Ajjahnon, also known as Joan Green, is now subject to entry of a judgment by the court in the amount of \$26,973.16, with interest to accrue as provided by law.
