SYNOPSIS

In October 2010, the petitioner filed an appeal contending that his employment was terminated by the respondent in a reduction in force, in violation of his tenure and seniority rights. A hearing in the matter was scheduled for October 31, 2011 at the Office of Administrative Law (OAL). Petitioner received appropriate notice of the hearing, but failed to appear. Accordingly, the ALJ dismissed the petition.

Upon review, the Commissioner concurred with the ALJ that because petitioner failed to appear at the scheduled hearing, the matter is appropriately dismissed for failure to prosecute.
