The record of this matter – wherein petitioner challenges the suspension of her school bus

license, notwithstanding that she admittedly left a student on the bus after the completion of her route -

and the advisement of the petitioner's failure to appear at the scheduled hearing, transmitted to the

Commissioner by the Office of Administrative Law (OAL) pursuant to N.J.A.C. 1:1-14.4, along with

copies of notifications sent to the petitioner by the OAL on January 28, 2013 providing her thirteen (13)

days to submit an explanation for such nonappearance, have been reviewed. There being no explanation

filed by petitioner – who bore the burden of proving why her bus license should not be suspended – this

matter is no longer deemed to be a contested matter before the Commissioner and is hereby dismissed

with prejudice.

Respondent is hereby directed to notify the Motor Vehicle Commission of its obligation

pursuant to N.J.S.A. 18A:39-28 et seq. to suspend petitioner's school bus S" endorsement on her driver's

license for six months, and to notify petitioner's employer that she is ineligible – for the period of

suspension – to continue employment as a school bus driver.
