

At its meeting of September 21, 2000, the State Board of Examiners agreed to a settlement in <u>In the Matter of the Teaching Certificates of Richard Anzuini</u>, Docket No. 491-01/99, a case which began when the Board of Examiners issued an Order to Show Cause to Anzuini as to why his certificates should not be revoked or suspended. Anzuini holds Teacher of Music, Supervisor and Principal certificates in New Jersey. As a result of the litigation, Anzuini and the Board of Examiners have entered into a settlement agreement that includes the voluntary surrender of Anzuini's teaching certificates. In accord with the agreement, Anzuini forwarded the original certificates at issue to the State Board of Examiners.

Anzuini also acknowledged that the voluntary surrender of his certificates would have the same force and effect as a revocation. In accord with the Stipulation of Settlement, the Board of Examiners voted to withdraw the Order to Show Cause against Anzuini at its November 2, 2000 meeting.

Having confirmed that the certificate holder agreed to the revocation of his certificates, it is therefore, ORDERED, that Richard Anzuini's Teacher of Music, Supervisor and Principal certificates be revoked on this 2nd day of November 2000.
