JUSTIN MANNICK : ORDER OF REVOCATION

At its meeting of September 21, 2012, the State Board of Examiners reviewed an affidavit that Justin Mannick had submitted. In January 2012, Mannick was convicted of Theft of Movable Property. As a result of the conviction, Mannick was disqualified from public school employment pursuant to *N.J.S.A. 18A:6-7.1 et seq.* Mannick currently holds a Teacher of Physical Education Certificate of Eligibility With Advanced Standing, issued in August 2005, a Teacher of Physical Education certificate, issued in June 2006, a Teacher of Health and Physical Education certificate, issued in February 2007 and a Teacher of Driver Education certificate, issued in March 2007.

Mannick agreed to relinquish his certificates with the force and effect of a revocation and all attendant consequences in his affidavit to that effect to the New Jersey State Board of Examiners. At its meeting of September 21, 2012, the Board voted to accept Mannick's relinquishment with the force and effect of a revocation pursuant to *N.J.A.C. 6A:9-17.8.*

Accordingly, on this 21st day of September 2012 it is therefore ORDERED that the revocation of Justin Mannick's Teacher of Physical Education Certificate of Eligibility With Advanced Standing, and Teacher of Physical Education, Teacher of Health and Physical Education and Teacher of Driver Education certificates be effective immediately.
