At its meeting of July 25, 2013, the New Jersey State Board of Examiners (Board) reviewed an affidavit that Ronald J. Murphy had submitted. Murphy pled guilty in 1974 to a charge of Debauching or Imperiling the Morals of a Child. Murphy currently holds a Teacher of Social Studies certificate, issued in September 1969.

Murphy agreed to relinquish his certificate with the force and effect of a revocation and all attendant consequences in his affidavit to that effect to the Board. At its meeting of July 25, 2013, the Board voted to accept Murphy's relinquishment with the force and effect of a revocation pursuant to *N.J.A.C.* 6A:9-17.8.

Accordingly, on this 25th day of July 2013 it is therefore ORDERED that Ronald J. Murphy's Teacher of Social Studies certificate be revoked effective immediately.
