JENNA L. LEAHEY : ORDER OF REVOCATION

At its meeting of June 15, 2017, the New Jersey State Board of Examiners (Board) reviewed an affidavit that the Morris County Prosecutor's Office had submitted regarding Jenna L. Leahey. On January 17, 2017, Leahey pled guilty to Endangering the Welfare of a Child-Sexual Conduct with Child by Caretaker (2nd degree). On April 10, 2017, Leahey was sentenced to five years in prison, parole supervision for life, Megan's Law registration and notification requirements and ordered to have no contact with the victim. Leahey currently holds a Teacher of English Certificate of Eligibility With Advanced Standing, issued in June 2007 and a Teacher of English certificate, issued in June 2008.

Leahey agreed to relinquish her certificates with the force and effect of a revocation and all attendant consequences in her affidavit to that effect to the Board. At its meeting of June 15, 2017, the Board voted to accept Leahey's relinquishment with the force and effect of a revocation pursuant to *N.J.A.C.* 6A:9B-4.7.

Accordingly, on this 15th day of June 2017, it is therefore ORDERED that Jenna L. Leahey's Teacher of English Certificate of Eligibility With Advanced Standing and her Teacher of English certificate be revoked, effective immediately.
