This matter was opened by the Board of Examiners (Board) by way of an Order to Show Cause issued to Lee Kornhauser as to why his teaching certificates should not be revoked. Kornhauser currently holds a Teacher of Elementary School certificate, issued in July 1988 and a Principal Certificate of Eligibility, issued in July 1996. After the teaching certification matter was transmitted to the Office of Administrative Law for hearing, Kornhauser presented a proposal to the Board in which he would agree to the relinquishment of his certificates with the force and effect of a revocation pursuant to *N.J.A.C.* 6A:9B-4.7. Kornhauser did not admit or concede the truth of the allegations in the Order to Show Cause. After reviewing the proposal, at its meeting of June 15, 2017, the Board voted to accept it. Accordingly, on this 15th day of June 2017, Lee Kornhauser's Principal Certificate of Eligibility and his Teacher of Elementary School certificate are hereby REVOKED, effective immediately. It is further ORDERED that Kornhauser return the above-mentioned certificates to the Secretary of the State Board of Examiners, Office of Certification and Induction, P.O. Box 500, Trenton, NJ 08625-0500 within 30 days of the mailing date of the decision.
