Classrooms are tailored to meet individual needs relative to class size, age appropriateness, educational content, and teaching approach. Each student has an IEP as well as an individual behavior management program. Education is provided, across classroom and residential settings, to help replace maladaptive behaviors with positive responses and increased appropriate social skills and communication skills. Program Description

The Institute for Developmental Disabilities, Inc. (IDDI)-Crystal Springs School provides a 12 month residential education and treatment for students, ages three-twenty two, who have severe cognitive impairments and may have secondary disabilities, medical, and/or behavioral issues. Students attend classes five days each week where academic lessons are combined with related services recommendations. Direct related services are also provided by the therapy assistants when indicated. Each class has several periods per week of adaptive physical education in the gym and one period at the Rehab Center which includes time in the indoor pool. Psychology services include behavior programs and a consulting psychiatrist for medication oversight. Nurses and nurses aides are on duty 24 hours a day. The residential services have awake overnight staff and out-of-school staff who provide reinforcement of self-care, socialization/behavior, and therapy skills. Class size ratio for the school program is 1 teacher:3 aides:8 students.

Special education is provided in the context of a behavior-oriented environment to male and female students, ages 5-13 years, who have emotional disturbance and/or specific learning disabilities, with moderate academic under-performance. The school is divided into three buildings: Batavia Learning Center for the primary elementary grades and the learning support classroom, Founder's Hall for the upper elementary grades, and Schar Building for the middle school grades. The learning support classroom is designed for students with severe cognitive, adaptive, and educational deficits. In addition, there is a sensory integration classrooms for students in need of daily sensory activities. Individual therapy, speech therapy, and occupational therapy are available at an additional cost. One to one assistance is available at an hourly rate. The residential services rate includes nursing, cottage counselors, administrative review and oversight, clinical programming and case management.
