Chris,

I have gone through the plan. Very comprehensive, ambitious and badly needed. It has raised the bar for the other states. Congratulations!

A few questions that can be discussed during the call.

- (1) For energy efficiency programs (EE) and demand response (DR) programs, how are the impacts developed? I noticed that RTP impacts had not been developed, yet they figure in the aggregate impacts. We have models that can be used to forecast such impacts (and not just for RTP; in fact, we have just completed forecasts with these models for California, MISO, PJM and ERCOT in addition to generating them for the US as a whole and by each of the four Census Regions).
- (2) Have costs and benefits of these EE and DR options been quantified to determine if the projected levels are cost-effective?

I did not come across any modeling references in the plan so if there are some, please send them to me.
