This matter arises from an allegation that Ali Houshmand, Rowan University President, violated the Conflicts of Interest Law by circumventing the normal recruitment process to hire friends into positions at the University, including Mira Lalovic-Hand, Kenneth Blank and Anthony Lowman.

After considering the results of an investigation into the allegations against President Houshmand, the Commission <u>dismissed</u> the matter pursuant to N.J.A.C. 19:61-3.1(g).
