Deadline for "Intent to Apply" extended to May 1, 2015

The Office of Tobacco Control, Nutrition and Fitness has posted the notice of availability of grant funds on the New Jersey Department of Health's website. These grants are supported through a CDC funding opportunity (**CDC-RFA-DP15-1509**) entitled, "**National State-Based Tobacco Control Program Grant**".

It is an open and competitive request for applications and will provide 3 grants to support the following:

- **Statewide Communications/Coalition Building and Local Policy Development (\$325,000)**
- **Smoke-Free Housing/Worksite Wellness (\$200,000)**
- **Tobacco Cessation Promotion through Health Care Systems (\$95,000)**

The project period is from **July 1, 2015 through March 28, 2016**. It is a five year CDC grant that will be renewed subject to the availability of funds and the awarded grantees' documented progress towards project goals.
