

## F. Vaccine Distribution and Use Overview

Vaccine Distribution and Use provides guidance on the elements of a pandemic vaccination program, including planning for distribution, monitoring of adverse events, tracking of vaccine supply and administration, vaccine coverage, communications, legal preparedness and training. This section also comprises:

- Estimates of vaccine by county, based upon availability, dose required and Centers for Disease Control & Prevention guidance
- Reference to New Jersey's Strategic National Stockpile plan that uses LINCS Agency Receipt, Stage and Storage Sites to directly receive vaccine
- Reference to LINCS Agency plans for mass clinics, including the locations of Points of Dispensing (PODs), use of volunteers, security and coordination with law enforcement
- Training requirements for clinic staff, including Personal Protective Equipment
- Data collection at PODs using NJDHSS' Immunization Information System Registry
- Just-in-time training for use of NJ Preparedness Vaccination System to track vaccine administration and NJ Emergency Preparedness Inventory System to track vaccine inventory
- Designated NJDHSS Vaccine Safety Officer
- Process for designating target groups (Continuing dialogue is occurring for this issue and updates will be added to this plan as they become available.)
- Verification process for target groups at clinics
