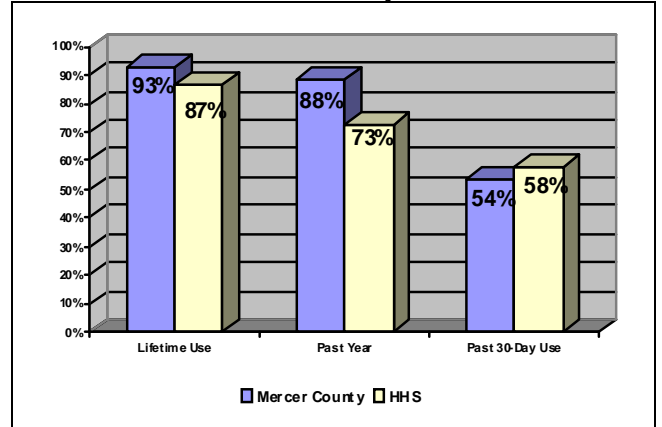

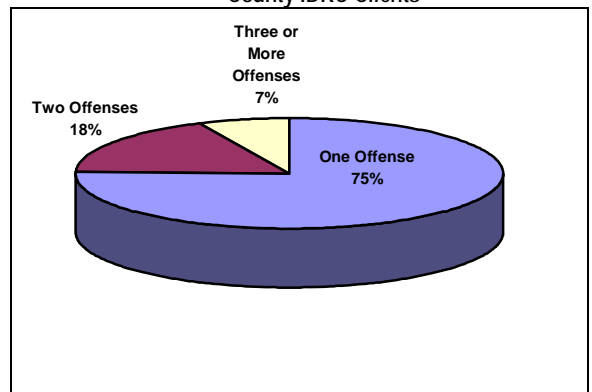

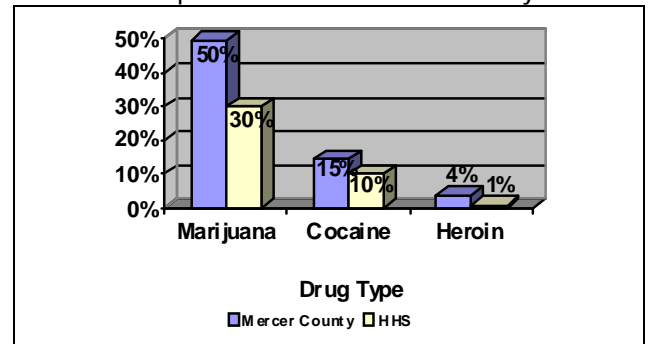
Alcohol Use by Mercer County IDRC Clients Compared with 2003 NJ Household Survey



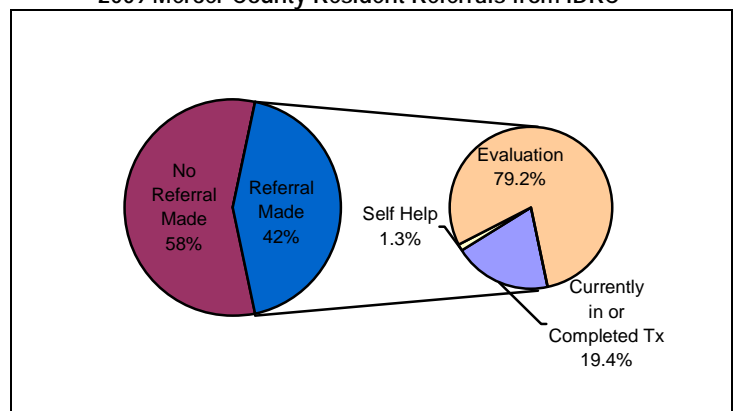
Number of Alcohol-Related Offenses on DMV Records of Mercer County IDRC Clients

2009 Mercer County Resident Referrals from IDRC



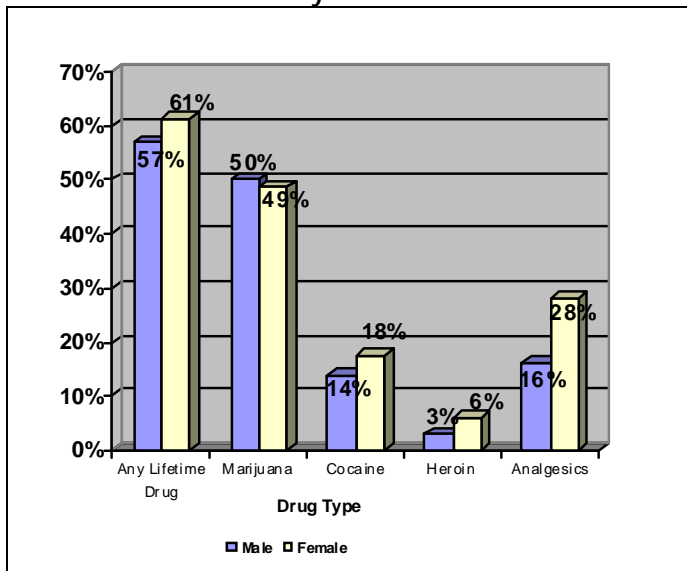
