Notice of Postponement of Certificate of Need Call for New Pediatric Intensive

**Care Beds** 

**Take notice** that, in compliance with N.J.S.A. 26:2H-1 et seq. (P.L. 1971, c. 136,

as amended), and N.J.A.C. 8:33, Judith M. Persichilli, R.N., B.S.N., M.A., Commissioner,

New Jersey Department of Health (Department), hereby publishes notice that the

September 1, 2023, call for certificate of need (CN) applications for new pediatric

intensive care beds, is hereby postponed.

On October 2, 2017, the Department issued a certificate of need call for pediatric

intensive care beds. See 49 N.J.R. 3367(c). In 2018, four facilities were awarded a total

of 22 pediatric intensive care beds.

In April and May of 2023, the Department conducted a survey of the facilities that

were previously awarded pediatric intensive care beds. The data the Department

received from the facilities indicates that there are 22 unimplemented pediatric intensive

care beds in various areas throughout the State. Accordingly, due to the fact that these

previously awarded, but unimplemented beds could have an impact on a needs

assessment, it is necessary to delay the September 1, 2023 call for pediatric intensive

care beds at this time.

This postponement will allow the Department sufficient time to complete its

evaluation of need, and to also provide potential applicants and affected parties sufficient

time to respond appropriately to a certificate of need call notice in the event the

Department determines that a call is appropriate. If the Department proceeds with the call, then a call for pediatric intensive care unit beds will be published in an upcoming publication of the New Jersey Register, providing the necessary time for both potential applicants and interested parties to respond to the call notice. In the alternative, if the determination is made to cancel the call, then the Department will publish a cancellation notice in the New Jersey Register.
