NAME OF GRANT PROGRAM:

New Jersey Commission on Brain Injury Research

GRANT PROGRAM NO. 2010-01&02-BIR

STATUTORY AUTHORITY:

P.L. 2003, C:200, N.J.S.A. 52:9EE, et seq

TYPE OF AWARDS TO BE ISSUED:

Cost Reimbursement

PURPOSE FOR WHICH THE GRANT PROGRAM FUNDS WILL BE USED:

To fund brain injury research projects that focus on nerve regeneration as a means to cure brain injury.

AMOUNT OF MONEY IN THE GRANT PROGRAM:

Approximately \$8,000,000 should be available for three year awards ranging from \$495,000 for an individual research project with an emphasis on (1) strategies to promote neuronal repair and regeneration after traumatic brain injury, or (2) translational research that establishes the relevance of basic research findings to clinical application in human subjects and up to \$1,980,000 for a multi-investigatory project that supports collaborative research among at least 3 investigators from different laboratories with an emphasis on traumatic brain injury.. One and two year grants will be considered.

ELIGIBLE APPLICANTS MUST COMPLY WITH THE FOLLOWING REQUIREMENTS:

1. Terms and Conditions for the Administration of Grants
2. General and specific Grant Compliance requirements issued by the Granting Agency.
3. Applicable Federal Cost Principles relating to the Applicant

GROUP OR ENTITIES WHICH MAY APPLY FOR THE GRANT PROGRAM:

Grants are awarded to approved, non-profit institutions located in New Jersey that have demonstrated capabilities to conduct the research.

QUALIFICATIONS NEEDED BY APPLICANT TO BE CONSIDERED FOR A GRANT:

Proposals are evaluated based upon scientific merit, study feasibility, and goal relativeness as determined by a review committee. Additional factors considered in the review include, but are not limited to, qualifications of investigators, research facilities, and scientific merit. See internet webpage www.nj.gov/health/njbir.
