PURPOSE FOR WHICH THE GRANT PROGRAM FUNDS WILL BE USED:

To train talented young people who are interested in persuing nerve regeneration and brain injury research.

AMOUNT OF MONEY IN THE GRANT PROGRAM:

Approximately \$400,000 should be available for three year awards with annual variable funding levels, \$40,000 to \$54,000, based on years of experience for postdoctoral fellowships, and \$27,500 per year for graduate student fellowships.

ELIGIBLE APPLICANTS MUST COMPLY WITH THE FOLLOWING REQUIREMENTS:

1. Terms and Conditions for the Administration of Grants
2. General and specific Grant Compliance requirements issued by the Granting Agency.
3. Applicable Federal Cost Principles relating to the Applicant

GROUP OR ENTITIES WHICH MAY APPLY FOR THE GRANT PROGRAM:

Grants are awarded to approved, non-profit institutions located in New Jersey that have demonstrated capabilities to conduct the research. Individuals do not directly receive the award.

QUALIFICATIONS NEEDED BY APPLICANT TO BE CONSIDERED FOR A GRANT:

Applicants must be enrolled in an approved course of study directly related to brain injury research at a non-profit research institution in New Jersey. Postdoctoral fellows must have appropriate degrees and credentials. See internet webpage www.nj.gov/health/njbir.
