


Distribution of any Reported WRA among Ever-Employed Adults with Current Asthma, by Household Income and Respondent Education

The Figures below are based on those with current asthma who have ever been employed outside the home. Reports of work-related asthma varied with income and with education—ever-employed adults with current asthma and with higher levels of household income and education had less reported work-related asthma of any kind. The sample size was insufficient to look at factors associated with work-related asthma as diagnosed by a health professional.

HOUSEHOLD INCOME


