


Distribution of Confirmed WRA Cases by Primary Occupation

The following figure shows the distribution of confirmed WRA cases in the top five identified occupational groups. Production occupations represent the largest occupational category (see page 2), and includes occupations such as machine operators, assemblers, and laborers.
