




FY2010 EOF Budget Distribution(Allocations)






Projected Undergraduate Enrollment











By Sector




By Race/Ethnicity





By Age




By Gender

Programs received a 1 time 10% funding increase during sum2007





3rd Semester Retention Rates


Sector Cohort Averages

(2 Yr Moving Averages)





5th Semester Retention Rates - Sector Cohort Averages (2 Yr Moving Averages)





6-Yr Sector Average Cohort Graduation Rates (2 Yr Moving Averages)




Average EOF Sector Equity Indices
