

A. Accreditation Status

1. Institutional Accreditation

Hudson County Community College is accredited by the Commission on Higher Education of the Middle States Association of Colleges and Schools, 3624 Market Street, Philadelphia, PA 19104, (215) 662-5606. The Commission on Higher Education is an institutional accrediting agency recognized by the U.S. Secretary of Education and the Commission on Recognition of Postsecondary Accreditation. Accreditation was most recently reaffirmed in February 1998. The five-year Periodic Review Report was submitted by the College June 1, 2002.

2. Professional Accreditation
