2. Public Service Activities

CCM pursues funding from both public and private external sources to fund scholarships, improve teaching and learning, acquire state of the art equipment and provide public services. 2008-2009 was a successful year in this regard with over \$760,000 dollars garnered for the College. Projects worthy of note include:

- The new Planetarium campaign was completed successfully in 2009, with more than \$610,000 raised against a goal of \$250,000 for the renovation of the facility.
- Over \$200,000 was raised for scholarships to assist students with tuition and fees.
- The College's 40th Anniversary Gala produced net proceeds of \$65,000, which will be dedicated to the General Scholarship Program.
- The nursing program received significant support, including \$250,000 from Chilton Memorial Hospital, Morristown Memorial Hospital and Saint Clare's Hospital for the Weekend Nursing Program.

During 2008-2009 year, the Special Events department provided public service through events that stimulated and enriched the social, cultural, professional and recreational climate of the community. Many of the programs were co-sponsored by the Office of Campus Life. Program expenses are subsidized by the College to keep ticket prices affordable and accessible to the local communities.
