To: DDD Qualified Providers

As you know, the Division of Developmental Disabilities has been in the process of transitioning to a rate-based fee-for-service system for several years now.

Effective July 1, 2017:

- All new individuals entering Division services (including 2017 graduates) will be enrolled directly into the new system.
- The Division will begin converting individuals currently served by contracted and qualified providers from their current service plan and payment structure to the new fee-for-service system.

To continue to provide services in the fee-for-service system, you must determine whether you will **(a)** apply to become a Medicaid/DDD approved provider of reimbursable services and bill directly through Molina Medicaid, OR **(b)** offer classes/programs **reimbursable only under the "Goods & Services" category** and billed via DDD's new fiscal intermediary, Public Partnerships LLC (PPL).

Qualified providers that meet the qualifications and wish to provide reimbursable services in the new system as a Medicaid/DDD approved provider must complete these two steps:

- **By June 15, 2017:** Enroll with Public Partnerships so that you can continue to be paid via DDD's fiscal intermediary (transitioning from Easter Seals to Public Partnerships effective July 1) until your Medicaid/DDD application is approved and you begin billing through Molina Medicaid.
- **By July 1, 2017:** Submit the Combined Application to Become a Medicaid/DDD Approved Provider (if you haven't already) to ensure you are ready to provide and bill for services once the conversion of individuals into fee-for-service begins.

Qualified providers who wish to offer classes/programs in the new system that are reimbursable only under the Goods & Services category must complete the following step:

- **By June 15, 2017:** Enroll with Public Partnerships to ensure you will continue to be paid for services once the transition from Easter Seals to Public Partnerships goes into effect on July 1.
