From the North:

Garden State Parkway South to Exit 140A (Rt. 22) . Rt. 22 West to New Providence Rd. jughandle. Cross over Rt. 22. Children's Specialized Hospital is less than 1/4 mile on the left.

From the South:

Garden State Parkway North to Exit 135. Follow signs to Westfield and proceed on Central Ave. Stay on Central Ave. to Broad St. Turn right onto Broad St. and make an immediate left onto Mountain Ave. Stay on Mountain Ave. until the first light, which is New Providence Rd. Turn left onto New Providence Rd. Children's Specialized Hospital is less than 1/2 mile on the right.

From Route 73 South, take Brick Road jughandle onto Brick Road East. Hospital Complex is ahead on left. Make a left into the Virtua parking lot and proceed to the center building marked Marlton Rehabilitation Hospital / Weisman Children's Rehabilitation Hospital. Weisman Children's Rehabilitation Hospital is located on the third floor. The Weisman Children's Outpatient Rehabilitation Center is located next door in the West Jersey Medical Plaza building, 94 Brick Road, Suite 102.

From New York or Newark, take the New Jersey turnpike North and South to Exit 11 (Garden State Parkway). Take the Garden State Parkway North to Exit 131, making a right off the exit onto Route 27 South. At the second light, make a right onto Wood Avenue. At the first light, make a left onto Oak Tree Road. Go through two traffic lights and the facility is about 1-2 miles on the right. You will see a sign on Oak Tree Road for Hartwyck, in front of an old school building. The Center for Head Injuries is located in the building behind the old school building. Turn right into the parking lot and drive to the parking lot and building in the back. Reception will be able to direct you to the appropriate room once you are in the building.

If you take the Garden State Parkway South to Exit 131, continue as above, except note that when you enter Route 27, you will make a right onto Wood Avenue at the first traffic light.
