

Did You Know?

Women with developmental disabilities are 4-10 times as likely to be sexually assaulted than their non-disabled peers

Women with disabilities are often abused by individuals responsible for providing personal care

Studies suggest more than 80% of women with developmental disabilities have been sexually assaulted

Only 3% of abuse cases involving the developmentally disabled are ever reported

Less than 10% of rape crisis and domestic violence agencies report having a line item in their budgets for disability-related accommodations
