

What is Child Care Resource and Referral (CCR&R)?

CCR&Rs take the guesswork out of finding and paying for child care.

CCR&Rs help New Jersey families find child care, evaluate child care and for eligible families, pay for child care.

CCR&Rs increase the supply of quality child care.

- CCR&Rs provide training and technical assistance to child care providers and;
- Promote the development of new child care spaces based on demand for services

CCR&Rs help create child care solutions for communities.

- CCR&Rs conduct community needs assessments;
- Administer Family Child Care Registration Program and other initiatives designed to improve the quality of child care services;
- Manage child care subsidy programs for low to middle income working families, families seeking self sufficiency and participating in WFNJ, children under the supervision of DYFS, children being cared for by relatives (Kinship Care) and children needing child care before/after DOE preschool services in designated School Districts and.
- Analyze and report on child care supply and demand.

By offering a blend of direct services and planning services, CCR&Rs help families and communities ensure that families in NJ have access to information and support for all of their child care needs.
