SFY 2014 MAXIMUM CHILD CARE PAYMENT RATES

Table with columns for care types (Licensed, Accredited, Registered, Non-Registered) and rows for age groups (Infants & Toddlers, Early Preschool, Preschool, School-Age) and care durations (Full Time, 3/4 Time, Part Time, 1/4 Time).

The amounts listed above represent the maximum authorized rates for child care. Care given for any portion of an hour shall be rounded to the next full hour. For example, one hour and 15 minutes is rounded to two hours.

Proportionate to the full time and part time rates listed above, maximum amounts paid only through the TANF Work First New Jersey and Transitional Child Care program include rates for 3/4 time (4 or 5 hours per day) and 1/4-time (1 hour per day).

NJCK utilizes only 'Full Time Care' and 'Part Time Care' rates. 'Full Time Care' for NJCK is 6 hours or more and 'Part Time Care' for NJCK is less than 6 hours.

Approved Homes (other than DCF approved in-home day care), exceptional child care programs and babysitting for DCF/CPS clients are not applicable for DCF/CPS child care service use and are not payable through the NJCK Child Care Program.

Provider/caregivers eligible for accredited rates include:

- > Licensed child care centers accredited by the National Association for the Education of Young Children - National Academy of Early Childhood Programs, Council on Accreditation (COA) of Services for Families and Children, and National Early Childhood Professional Accreditation (NECPA);
> Registered family child care providers accredited by the National Association for Family Child Care;
> School age child care programs accredited by the National School Age Child Care Alliance; and
> Summer camps accredited by the American Camping Association.
