Purpose:

This Request for Proposal (RFP) was issued by the New Jersey Department of Human Services (DHS), Division of Mental Health and Addiction Services (DMHAS), to provide supportive, substance-free living environments and services for college students in recovery. This RFP is funded through Federal Substance Abuse Block Grant COVID-19 Supplement funding ending on March 14, 2023. Institutions that already have designated housing for students in recovery were eligible to apply for funding for recovery programs and related services. Each college awardee will be required to: provide individual and group substance abuse recovery-oriented strategies, provide assessment, academic, and relapse prevention services to students, and other appropriate services. Designated recovery housing may include a dorm, floor, wing or other designated area within an existing residential building or other student housing and does not require that an entire dormitory be substance-free. The successful bidders will ensure that the services provide ensure diversity, inclusion, equity, and cultural and linguistic competence to the target population. DMHAS awarded three contracts in the total amount of \$1,124,999.
