Name of Program: Nurse Care Management in Opioid Treatment Programs (OTPs)

Purpose:

This Request for Proposal (RFP) was issued by the New Jersey Department of Human Services (DHS), Division of Mental Health and Addiction Services (DMHAS) to embed Nurse Care Managers (NCMs) into Opioid Treatment Programs (OTPs) to manage physical health services, including hepatitis C, for individuals being served at the OTP. This RFP is funded through the Substance Abuse and Mental Health Services Administration's (SAMHSA) State Opioid Response (SOR) grant. The SOR grant period is September 30th, 2020 to September 29, 2022. Funding is available through September 29, 2022, depending on federal appropriations. The Nurse Care Management in OTPs initiative is intended to provide services across the state with special focus on high need areas in both urban and rural settings. Special focus will be given to those who are at risk for, or who have been diagnosed with, hepatitis C. The NCM is expected to coordinate this treatment into the full array of services offered to each client served by the OTP. The initiative adds nurse care management, along with case management and health coaching, to assist people with improvement of their overall health and well-being with an emphasis on hepatitis C and integration of their behavioral and medical healthcare. In addition to onsite services, telehealth service options are also offered, thereby expanding the reach of nurse care management, case management and health coaching. DMHAS awarded five contracts in the total amount of \$1,332,809.
