**Name of Program:** Community Peer Recovery Center

**Purpose:**

This Request for Proposals (RFP) sought to develop regional Community Peer Recovery Centers (CPRC). The CPRC will be a place where individuals can access peer support, information about substance use disorder treatment, recovery support services, and information about other community resources in a supportive substance free environment. This RFP is funded through the Substance Abuse and Mental Health Services Administration’s (SAMHSA) State Opioid Response to Grants (SOR) supplemental funding. The SOR grant funding period is September 30, 2019 to September 29, 2020. Total funding is \$700,000 subject to federal appropriations. This funding is for start-up of seven small-scale recovery centers that will provide peer-to-peer recovery support services to prevent recurrence of substance use and promote sustained recovery. DMHAS awarded seven contracts in the amount of \$100,000 each.
