Early Intervention Support Services Awarded: April 18, 2022

Name of Program: Early Intervention Support Services (EISS)

**Purpose:** The Division of Mental Health and Addiction Services issued the following funding awards for the creation of EISS in ten (10) counties. EISS represents community based treatment alternatives for adults,18 years of age and older, with acute psychiatric symptoms, inclusive of individuals who have co-occurring conditions. New Jersey's EISS programs function as psychiatric urgent care clinics that offer adults access to crisis intervention services without having to rely on local hospital emergency departments. EISS programs provide rapid access to short term, recovery-oriented, crisis intervention services.

The awardees are as follows: Burlington, Cape May, Gloucester, Hunterdon, Passaic, Salem, Somerset, Sussex, Union and Warren.
