Name of Program: Expanded Hours for Substance Use Disorder in Outpatient Programs

## **Purpose:**

This Request for Proposal (RFP) was issued by the New Jersey Department of Human Services (DHS), Division of Mental Health and Addiction Services (DMHAS), for the development of Expanded Hours for Substance Use Disorder (SUD) Outpatient Programs. This RFP is funded through the Substance Abuse and Mental Health Services Administration's (SAMHSA) American Rescue Plan Act. The Expanded Hours for SUD Outpatient Programs is intended to be a one-year program that will provide increased access to outpatient treatment for individuals with a SUD. The purpose of outpatient services is to support, enhance, and encourage the emotional development of client's life skills in order to maximize their individual functioning during alternate times from standard business hours (after hours and weekends). Services will include: outpatient hours of operation for individual, group and/or family sessions, medication monitoring, education and administration hours. DMHAS made ten awards across ten counties in the total amount of \$1,920,763. No more than one award was issued in a county.
