Purpose:

This Request for Proposals (RFP) sought expansion of a network of providers for treatment of gambling disorders. The successful bidder will be responsible for all aspects of developing or expanding outpatient and short-term residential treatment services for gambling disorder. Responsibilities will include overseeing the provision of treatment, monitoring all aspects of service delivery, credentialing service providers, processing service authorizations and claims, and reporting to the Division of Mental Health Addiction Services (DMHAS). The goal of treatment for gambling disorder is to change unhealthy gambling behaviors, to help manage gambling urges, and to solve financial, work, and relationship problems that are caused by the addiction.

RFP funds are made available by the New Jersey Legislature in accordance with N.J.S.A. 5:12-95.29. DMHAS made one award in the amount of \$350,000.
