Name of Program: Maternal Wraparound Program

## **Purpose:**

This Request for Proposals (RFP) sought to develop intensive case management and recovery support services for opioid dependent pregnant and postpartum women. Opioid dependent pregnant women will be eligible for services through the Maternal Wraparound Program (M-WRAP) during pregnancy and up to one year after birth event. This program combines intensive case management, wraparound services and recovery supports for opioid dependent pregnant/postpartum women. Intensive case management will focus on developing a single, coordinated care plan for pregnant/postpartum women, their infants and families. Intensive Case Managers will work as liaisons to all relevant entities involved with each woman. Recovery Support Specialists will provide non-clinical assistance and recovery supports while maintaining follow-up with the women and their infants.

DMHAS will provide total funding of approximately \$1,181,415. Five regionalized contracts were awarded in the regions below. Awardees must serve all of the target counties identified in the region.
