Name of Program: Maternal Wraparound Program (M-WRAP)

## **Purpose:**

This Request for Proposal (RFP) was issued by the New Jersey Department of Human Services (DHS), Division of Mental Health and Addiction Services (DMHAS) to develop intensive case management, wraparound services and recovery support services for pregnant and postpartum women with substance use disorder. Pregnant women who are dependent on substances will be eligible for services through the Maternal Wraparound Program (M-WRAP) during pregnancy and up to one year after a birth event. Intensive case management will focus on developing a single, coordinated care plan for pregnant/postpartum women, their infants and families. Intensive Case Managers will work as liaisons to all relevant entities involved with each woman. Recovery Support Specialists will provide non-clinical assistance and recovery supports while maintaining follow-up with the women and their infants. The M-WRAP model is intended to promote maternal health, improve birth outcomes, and reduce the risks and adverse consequences of prenatal substance exposure. One contract was awarded for \$386,283. Awards were previously issued for Region 1: Cape May, Cumberland, Gloucester and Salem; Region 2: Ocean and Monmouth; Region 3: Hunterdon, Mercer, Middlesex and Somerset; Region 4: Essex, Hudson and Union; Region 6: Morris, Sussex and Warren counties; and Region 7: Atlantic, Camden and Burlington counties. This RFP is a rebid of Region 5: Passaic and Bergen counties.
