Name of Program: Opioid Overdose Recovery Program

**Purpose:** This Request for Proposals (RFP) sought to develop an Opioid Overdose Recovery Program (OORP) in Hunterdon County to respond to individuals reversed from opioid overdoses and treated at a hospital emergency department as a result of the reversal. This RFP is funded through the Substance Abuse and Mental Health Services Administration's (SAMHSA) State Targeted Response to the Opioid Crisis grant. Funding is available for FFY 2018 and may be available for FFY 2019. The Division of Mental Health and Addiction Services (DMHAS) will provide annualized funding of \$255,750 to one contractee subject to federal appropriations.

OORP will utilize Recovery Specialists and Patient Navigators to engage individuals reversed from an opioid overdose to provide non- clinical assistance, recovery supports and appropriate referrals for assessment and substance use disorder treatment. The Recovery Specialists and Patient Navigators will also maintain follow-up with these individuals. It is planned that, at minimum, recovery specialists will be accessible and on-call from Thursday evenings through Monday mornings in the specific locations where funding is made available.
