**Name of Program:** Temporary Sober Recovery Housing Services to Adult Drug Court Participants

**Purpose:** The Division of Mental Health and Addiction Services (DMHAS) on behalf of the New Jersey Judiciary, Administrative Office of the Courts (AOC) has made the following awards to provide temporary sober recovery housing to Adult Drug Court participants in New Jersey. Awardees will provide a safe and sober recovery environment in the form of temporary housing. Up to 50 beds will be annually used to serve 150 Drug Court participants in the community. The maximum length of time an individual can remain in this housing is 4 months. The expectation is that these beds will turnover a minimum of three (3) times per year.

Total funding is \$1.2 million over a three (3) year period of time with a maximum annualized amount of \$400,000.00 to support this request, funding is subject to Federal appropriations.
