Name of Program: Women's Set Aside Halfway House Beds for Pregnant Women and Women with Dependent Children

Purpose: This Request for Letters of Interest (RLI) sought letters of interest from the DMHAS currently contracted Halfway House provider community regarding the development of new capacity to meet the needs of the Women's Set Aside Federal Block Grant. The Women's Set Aside requires States to expend a percentage of their annual Substance Abuse Prevention and Treatment Block Grant allotment on services designed for pregnant women and women with dependent children.

Total Women's Set Aside Federal Block Grant annualized funding will be available for one (1) award for up to four (4) halfway house women with children beds at \$37,664 per bed totaling \$150,656. In addition one-time dollars up to \$25,000 total will be available for start-up costs such as recruitment of staff, securing equipment and minor renovation or refurbishing costs. This is not new funding and is a rebidding of existing funding.
