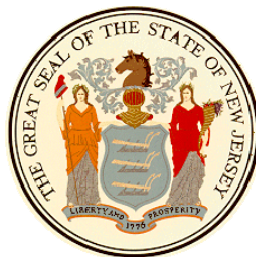

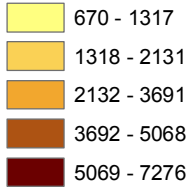

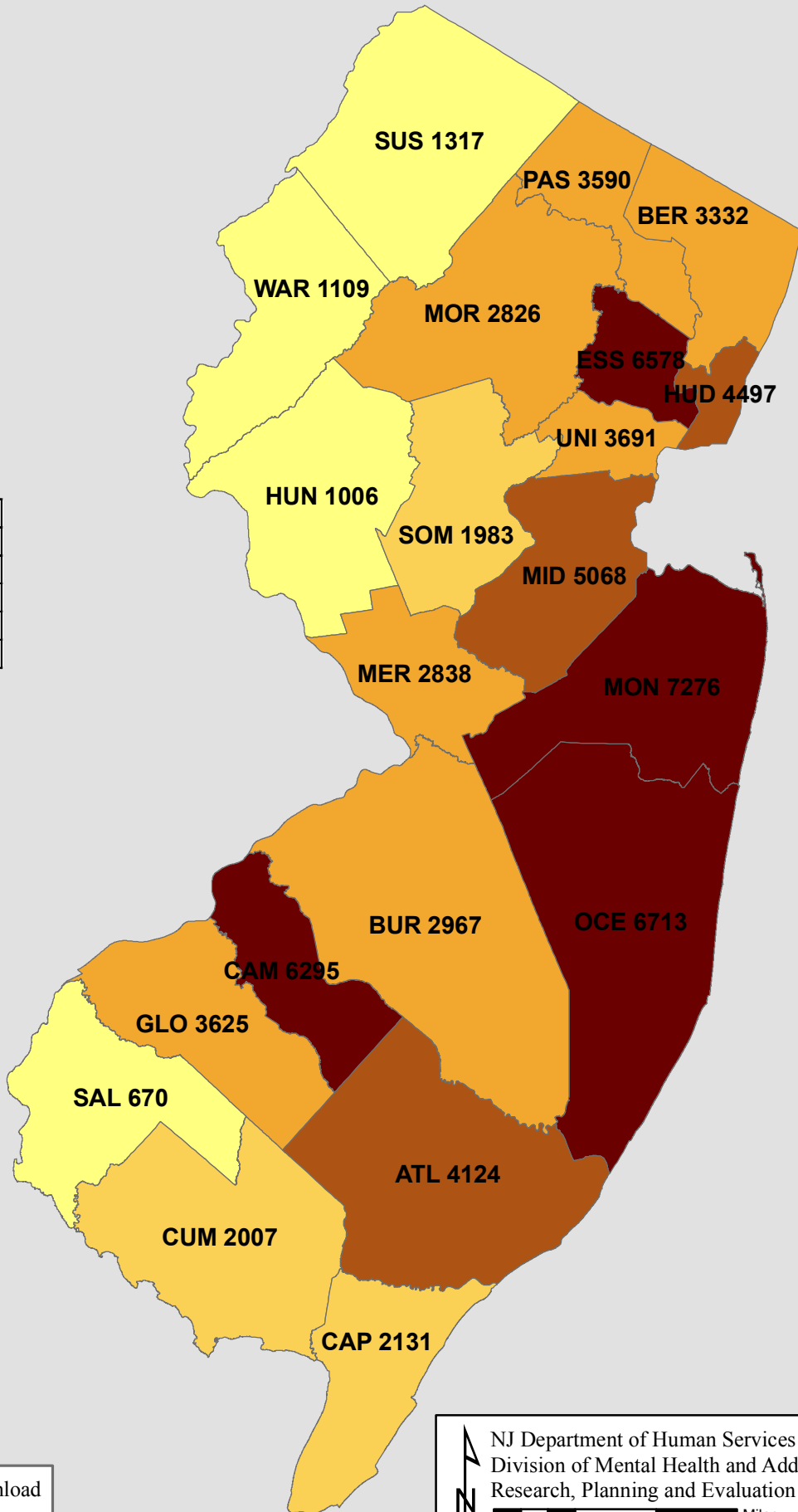
2012 Substance Abuse Admissions by County of Residence

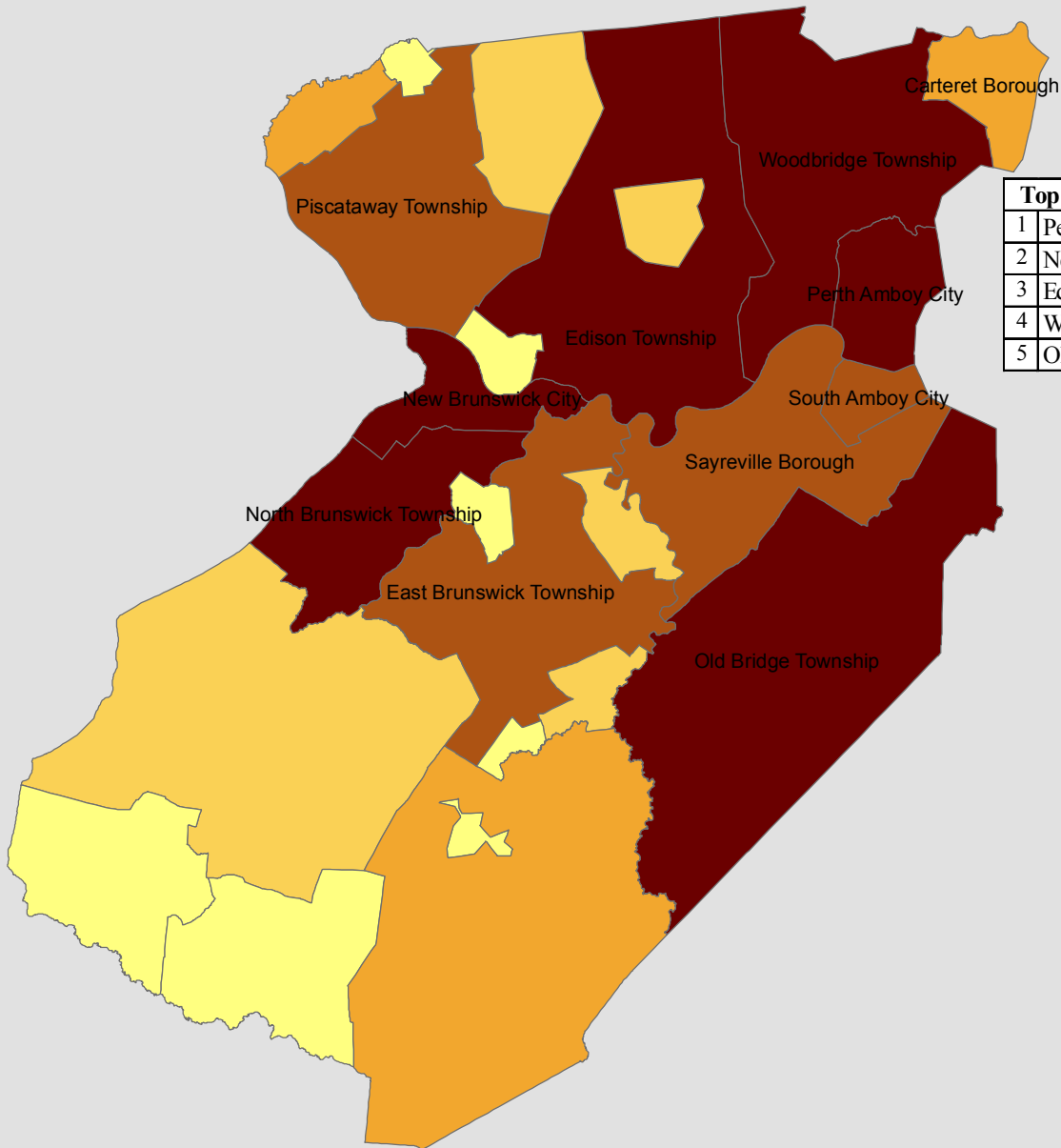
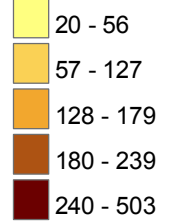

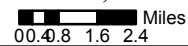
