Early Intervention Support Services (EISS)

Purpose:

The Division of Mental Health and Addiction Services (DMHAS) is seeking proposals that will permit the development of an Early Intervention Support Service (EISS) program that will provide rapid access to short term, recoveryoriented crisis intervention and crisis stabilization services for persons with a serious mental illness. EISS is a community based program aimed at offering individuals, who are a experiencing psychiatric crisis, a broad range of mental health services that can divert undue use of emergency room and in-patient programs. Early Intervention Support Service programs will provides a comprehensive range of pharmacologic, therapeutic, recovery and supportive services.

Amount of funding available:

DMHAS is seeking to competitively award one program in **Hudson** County. DMHAS has a total of \$1,000,000 available annually to support this initiative.

<u>Organizations that may apply</u>: In order to be eligible for consideration for this Request for Proposal, an applicant must be a fiscally viable corporation duly registered to conduct business within the State of New Jersey.

The applicant must demonstrate the ability to comply with all rules and regulations for any DMHAS program element of service proposed by the applicant.

The applicant must comply with the terms and conditions of the Department of Human Services' contracting rules and regulations as set forth in the DHS Standard Language Document, the <u>Contract Reimbursement Manual</u> (CRM), and the <u>Contract Policy and Information Manual</u> (CPIM).

Any fiscally viable corporation, as noted above, which meets the qualifications of the Department of Human Services' <u>Contract Policy and Information Manual</u>, N.J.A.C. 10:3, may apply.
