Name of Program: Legal Services to Super Storm Sandy Survivors

<u>Purpose</u>: The Office of Recovery, on behalf of the NJ Department of Children and Families, the NJ Department of Health, and the NJ Department of Human Services, seeks proposals to provide services to New Jersey residents with legal issues caused by Super Storm Sandy and that warrant professional legal assistance. The legal services being sought include but are not limited to landlord-tenant issues, evictions, insurance delays and or denials, consumer contract problems and mortgages/foreclosures.

<u>Amount of funding available</u>: The funding available through the contract(s) resulting from the subject Request for Proposal (RFP) is \$4.5 million.
