This notice provides advance notice that the New Jersey Department of Human Services, Division of Medical Assistance and Health Services, will be publishing a proposed rulemaking to amend N.J.A.C. 10:79B, Community Support Services (CSS) For Adults With Mental Illness.

The chapter contains two subchapters:

Subchapter 1 contains definitions used in the chapter, and the purpose, scope and provider eligibility.

Subchapter 2 contains rules related to beneficiary eligibility, program and licensure requirements, services offered, reimbursement, recordkeeping requirements, staffing requirements, and prior authorization procedures.

The proposed amendments will

- 1. Clarify that Integrated Case Management Services (ICMS) shall not be billed when an individual is receiving CSS services.
- 2. Require the use of a National Provider Identifier (NPI) and taxonomy codes by providers.

This notice provides you with an opportunity to comment on the upcoming amendments by **June 30, 2023**.

NOTE: You will be notified of the publication date of the proposed rulemaking once the date is finalized by the Office of Administrative Law, which will include a 60-day public comment period during which formal comments will be accepted.
