Petitioner appeals from Respondent Agency's denial of her application for Work First New Jersey/General Assistance ("WFNJ/GA") benefits. The Agency denied Petitioner WFNJ/GA benefits for allegedly failing to complete her 28-day work requirement. Because Petitioner appealed, the matter was transmitted to the Office of Administrative Law for a hearing. On September 29, 2015, the Honorable Gail M. Cookson, Administrative Law Judge ("ALJ"), held a plenary hearing, took testimony, and admitted documents into evidence.

On September 30, 2015, the ALJ issued an Initial Decision reversing the Agency's denial of Petitioner's WFNJ/GA benefits for failure to complete the 28-day work requirement in the given time frame. See Initial Decision at 3. Specifically, the ALJ found that Petitioner had complied with the 28-day work requirement by completing the requisite job searches, but had to travel to Florida to attend a brother in-law's funeral before she was provided with a letter of completion. Id. at 2. Based upon the foregoing, the ALJ concluded that Petitioner became eligible for WFNJ/GA benefits on June 18, 2015, the day Petitioner had come into compliance with her 28-day employment related activity, and directed that Petitioner be provided with retroactive benefits to that date. Id. at 3. I agree.

No Exceptions to the Initial Decision were filed.

As Director of the Division of Family Development, Department of Human Services, I have reviewed the record for this matter and the ALJ's Initial Decision. Following an independent evaluation of the record, I concur with the ALJ's decision in this matter and I hereby accept and adopt the Findings of Fact and Conclusions of Law as contained in the Initial Decision.
