



HIGH POINT STATE PARK
Sussex County

Located on the 13,019 acres of the unspoiled forest of High Point State Park stands a 1,803 foot monument. This is the highest point in New Jersey and can be seen from New York and Pennsylvania.

Construction on this monument to New Jersey veterans started in 1928 and was completed in 1930. The outside is made of New England granite and the inside is native stone.

High Point State Park is considered one of the Seven Natural Wonders of New Jersey.
